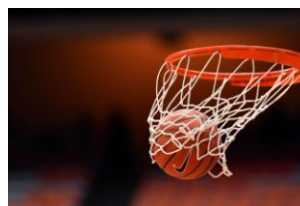


NO NACHOS THIS WEEK: No nachos this week but there will be Friday pizza (see page 3).◆

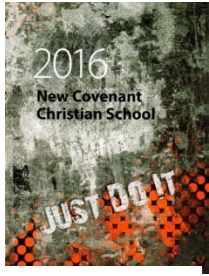
