NO MORE SHOEBOXES

NEEDED: The packing day will be **THIS Friday**.

This year, classes will be **working independently at varied times**. Students can bring in an item for the shoe boxes **plus \$1 to offset the cost of shipping**. Girls can buy items for a girl. Boys can buy items for a boy.

Suggested toys: Small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, small etch-a-sketch, toys that light up or make noise, slinkies, etc.

Suggested art supplies: Pens, pencils, pencil sharpeners, crayons, markers, stamps and ink pads, notebooks/paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.

Suggested personal items: Hygiene items, clothing (t-shirts, socks, hats, etc.), sunglasses, flashlights, jewelry, watches, hair clips, combs, bar soap, toothbrush.



KEEP IN "THE KNOW" NOT IN THE SNOW:

At NCCS, we have a communication system called the "phone tree". It is a way of communicating with parents by telephone regarding school cancellations for snow days, power outages, etc. Like last year,

parents have two options.

- Receive a notification via email or text message through an app called "Remind." This allows us to send a group text "announcement." Directions were sent via email. You can sign up anytime. **OR**
