FRIDAY PIZZA: Since there is no school this Friday, there will be no Friday pizza this week. We will resume next week! ♦

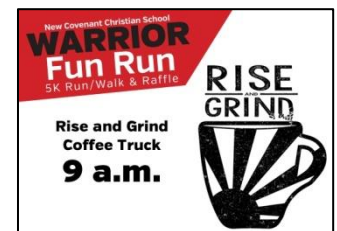


PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES TONIGHT AND THURSDAY: Parent Teacher Conferences are from **5-8pm**
