SHOEBOXES NEEDED —THANK YOU!! The packing day will be on Friday, **November 10th**. This year, classes will be **working independently at varied times** throughout the day. If you would like to help supervise, wrap and pack boxes, please contact your child's teacher. For secondary, contact Mrs. Nunn or Miss Hackbarth.

We are asking students to bring in items to fill the shoe boxes. Donations can be brought to school **November 6th through November 9th**. You don't need to buy everything on the list—**just an item or two plus \$1 or more to offset the cost of shipping**. Girls can buy items for a girl. Boys can buy items for a boy.

Suggested toys: Small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, small etch-a-sketch, toys that light up or make noise, slinkies, etc.

Suggested art supplies: Pens, pencils, pencil sharpeners, crayons, markers, stamps and ink pads, notebooks/paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.

Suggested personal items: Hygiene items, clothing (t-shirts, socks, hats, etc.), sunglasses, flashlights, jewelry, watches, hair clips, combs, bar soap, toothbrush.

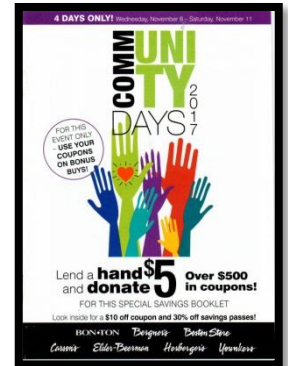


BASKETBALL: This year we plan to have a **3rd-5th Co-ed team** as we've had the last two years. The games will be on Saturdays at Our Savior
