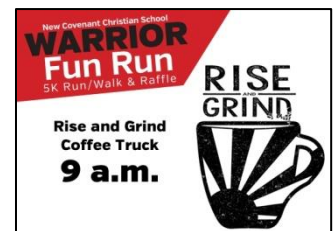
gets to school on time (**students arriving late will not be admitted to the test room**). If you have any questions, please contact the school. ♦

RAFFLE SALES INCENTIVES:

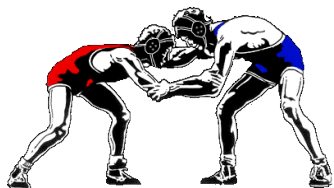
The class with the **best percentage of participation in the 5K** will win a sub sandwich lunch party. *Students in 2nd grade and lower can*
